Fox Hunts

This year's Spokane Hamfest will feature **two hidden transmitter hunts**: one for **young hunters** 14 years of age or less, and another for **all hunters**. Prizes will be awarded for the first person to find the hidden transmitter for each group -- a child will receive the ARRL Operators Manual and an adult will receive the ARRL Antenna Book, donated for prizes by the American Radio Relay League (ARRL). Each participant will need to provide his or her own receiver.

Additional details: The hidden transmitter will be transmitting on 146.565 MHz. You don't need to be a licensed amateur radio operator to join the fun. Usually you just need some kind of directional antenna and a handheld receiver, and skill. The kids' hunt will be in the morning, and be limited to locations within the University High School building. The all hunters contest will be in the afternoon, and may lead you to anywhere on the University High School property, indoors or outdoors.

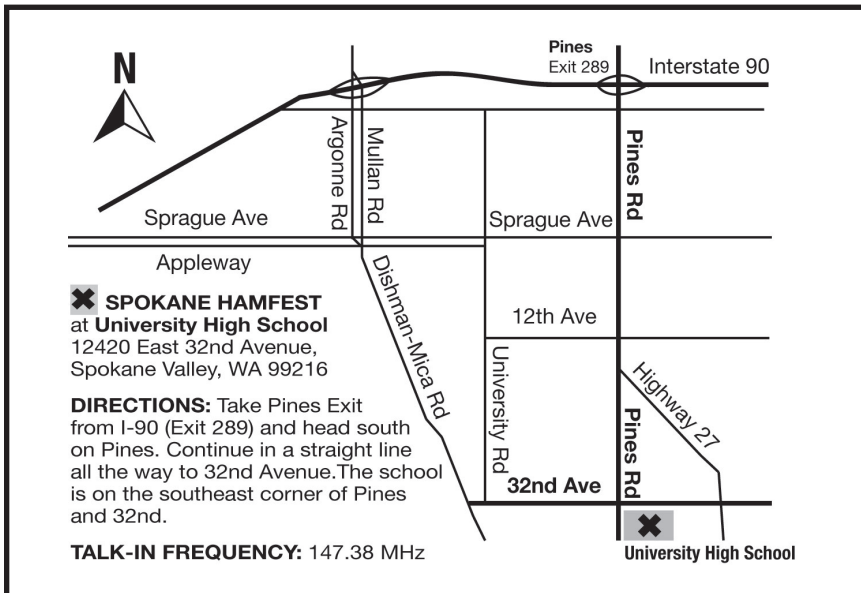

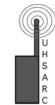
